



#### <u>THE NINE MONTHS</u> OF THE CHILD, JESUS IN THE WOMB OF MARY

Each year on December 25th we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ. For centuries the Church has also celebrated his conception on March 25, the feast of the Annunciation.

### THE THIRD MONTH - MAY 25 TO JUNE 25

Faith filled Joseph, believing the revelation that he is to be the protector of the Messiah, bravely stands by Mary's side, offering his strength and sense of mission as her body begins to accommodate her child. 






## **Our Lady of the Broken** A Journey of Hope

# Catholic Kids Column Love One Another

We often think of love as an emotion, like happiness or excitement. But Jesus tells us to love one another, and this shows us that love is more than just a feeling. Love is something we can choose to do. It is an action and a decision. Emotions, on the other hand, are reactions to what is happening around us. They come and go depending on our mood or circumstances. Love is much deeper than that.



Loving others is not always easy. Sometimes, it means sacrificing what we want for the sake of another person. Jesus is our greatest example of this. He loved us so much that he gave up his life for us. While we might never be asked to die for someone, we are often called to make smaller sacrifices. Maybe it's giving up time to help someone in need. Maybe it's letting go of anger and forgiving someone who has hurt us. Maybe it's choosing to

include someone who feels left out, even when it's inconvenient.

When Jesus tells us to love one another as I have loved you, he is not promising that it will always be easy. In fact, he is warning us that it might be hard. Love requires effort, patience, and sometimes sacrifice. But it is also the most important commandment he gives us. By loving others, we show that we belong to him. It is how the world will know we are his disciples.

So remember, love is not about how we feel-it is about what we choose to do. Jesus chose to love us when he gave his life for us, and now he calls us to do the same for one another. Love one another, not because it is easy, but because it is what Jesus asks of us.
